Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science (KITS), Divili, Peddapuram Mandal, Kakinada District, Andhra Pradesh, represented by Sri B Srinivasa Rao, Chairman, KITS Divili

Being the Second Party

Whereas Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science has agreed to collect and give away the dry recyclable waste including any kind of paper waste and old records generated in its campus and form Swachh Well being Out of Waste (WOW), Andhra Pradesh Chapter.

1. NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between KITS and Suraj Krishna Greeneries for the social cause of recycling of Dry Waste and Environment Protection through recycling.

 Time period: This MoU shall be for a period of one year commencing from the date of signing of this MoU.

2. Roles and Responsibilities of Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science:

- a. To ensure source segregation of dry and waste at College premise through its Teaching staff and housekeeping staff and students.
- b. Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science will give away any kind of paper waste, dry recyclable waste and old records to Suraj Krishna Greeneries at price agreed mutually. Suraj Krishna will pay as below rate: Paper: Rs.17/per Kg, Plastic: Rs.10/- per Kg, Cardboard: Rs.5/- to 10/- per Kg., Iron:Rs.20/per Kg.
- c. Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science shall form Swachh WOW Andhra Pradesh Chapter in the college with Student Volunteers and adopt nearby Schools or Colonies to promote Source Segregation through student volunteers.
- d. Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science shall provide students for Internship in WOW Program.
- e. Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science shall motivate students to bring dry recyclables like paper, plastic, metal etc. from their home and donate to WOW initiative.
- KITS will put-up color-coded bins for waste segregation at different points in college premises.

3. Roles and Responsibilities of Suraj Krishna Greeneries:

- a. ITC-AGS will train the house keeping staff on source segregation and through them inculcate the habit of source segregation among the other students.
- b. Suraj Krishna Greeneries will collect dry recyclable waste and old records from Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science and bring to the Dry Resource Collection Centre (DRCC) without any spillage.
- c. Suraj Krishna Greeneries will organize sorting of the dry waste into different categories, baling, and appropriate disposal of dry waste.
- d. Suraj Krishna Greeneries shall coordinate with ITC and undertake necessary measures for dispatch of the sorted recyclables for recycling at its own cost.

Suraj Krishna Greeneries will make payment to Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science directly into their accounts for the dry recyclable waste collected against the accurate weighment and the type or category of the dry waste. The payment shall be made no later than 15 days from the date of purchase of dry waste from the waste collector. Franchisee on the request of Kakinada Institute of Technology and Science may give New Notebooks and Stationery against the value of dry recyclable waste lifted.

4. Performance of Obligations

a. The details laid out in this MoU, notwithstanding the essence and spirit of this MoU is an understanding between KITS and Suraj Krishna Greeneries.

b. Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or sent by way of e-mail to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out in this contract or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other.

a. A confirmation by both the parties that no benefit, either in cash or kind has been provided by either party to the other party or to any officer or employee, or any relative associate institutions/companies in order to enter into this Agreement, and

6. Other Terms:

Force Majeure: Neither party shall be liable for damages for any delay or failure to perform its obligations here under, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party including without limitation, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earth quakes, explosions, acts of God or state or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order, whether valid or invalid, of any Governmental body.

. 7. Dispute Resolution:

It is understood by both the parties that this Agreement is for a social cause and not to make any profit out of the understanding. The Parties covenant that they will comply with all applicable laws and regulations in their conduct pursuant to this Agreement. Any dispute arising out of this Agreement shall be first attempted to settle amicably between the parties.

8. Arbitration

- a. Any dispute which is not resolved amicably shall be finally settled by binding arbitration in respect to the matters concerning to the MOU with the Sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the mutual consent of both the parties. The Parties agree that the decision or award resulting from arbitration shall be final and binding upon the Parties.
- b. Pending the submission of and/or decision on a dispute, the Parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under this Agreement without prejudice to a final adjustment in accordance with such arbitration award

9. Governing and Jurisdiction:

This Agreement is subjected to the Jurisdiction of Courts at Visakhapatnamor Mumbai.

The parties shall agree that it will not make use of, disseminate, or in any way disclose any confidential information to any person, firm or business. Furthermore, the existence of any discussions, negotiations or agreements in progress between the parties shall not be released to any form of public media without written approval of both parties.

10. Amendments

This Agreement and the Schedules together constitute a complete and exclusive understanding of the terms of the Agreement between the Parties on the subject hereof and no amendment or modification hereto shall be valid and effective unless agreed to by all the Parties hereto and evidenced in writing.
